This student must also be intending to attend post-secondary studies in the fall.</p>	<p>Valedictorian Award A cash award of \$100 is donated by Rosenort School. This award is presented to a graduating student who has been selected by the staff of Rosenort School as the valedictorian.</p>	<p>Excellence in Writing Bursary Graduates provide a humorous short story between 500-800 words submitted to the school office. <p>Steinbach Bible College This is a \$500 cash President's Entrance Scholarship. <i>Awarded by SBC upon acceptance of enrollment.</i></p>	<p>Continuing Education Bursary Lowe Farm Co-op Certificate and a \$500 cash award to a most deserving student with strong work ethics. The student must continue his/her education.</p>	<p>Chown Centennial Entrance Scholarship A cash award of \$500 is presented to one graduate who has achieved a minimum average of 85%. <i>This student will receive the scholarship upon a registration at the University of Manitoba in the fall.</i></p>
<p>Governor General's Academic Award This medal is awarded to the graduate with the highest academic average based on Grade 11 and Grade 12 courses.</p>	<p>Career Work Award This Plaque along with a \$200.00 cash award is presented to the student who has taken the most courses and maintained an average of 75% or higher in the area of career and workplace experience. The courses for this award include: Career life courses, vocational courses and apprenticeship courses.</p>	<p>Citizenship Trophy A trophy and a \$200 cash award donated by Rosenort Co-op. This award is presented to the graduate who has exemplified a caring, considerate, and positive attitude toward fellow students and staff.</p>

<p>Rosenort Chamber Of Commerce Scholarship</p> <p>A \$200 cash award is given to a graduating student who plans to pursue studies in the field of business and commerce.</p>	<p>Rosenort School English Trophy</p> <p>A trophy and \$200 cash award donated by Rosenort School. This trophy is presented to a student achieving an average of 75% or higher in English Language Arts 30S, 40S Literature and 40S Core.</p>	<p>French Trophy</p> <p>A trophy and \$100 cash award donated by Rosenort Motors. This award is presented to the student who has taken French 30S and 40S and has maintained an average of 75% or higher.</p>
<p>Mathematics/Science Trophy</p> <p>A trophy and cash award of \$100 is donated by Rosenort Credit Union. This award is presented to the student who has taken the most courses in Mathematics and Science maintaining an average of 75% or higher (a minimum of 5 courses). Subjects include: Mathematics 30S, Mathematics 40S, Biology 30S, Biology 40S, Chemistry 30S, Chemistry 40S, Physics 30S, Physics 40S.</p>	<p>Athletic Trophy</p> <p>A trophy and \$50 cash award donated by Herm Martens Family. This award is presented to a graduating male and female athlete who qualify under the following criteria for the current school year: based on athletic skill (all-star, MVP recognition), participation in major and minor sports, responsibility and leadership, cooperation, sportsmanship, positive ambassador for school/sport, spirit of school, decision based on input from concerned coaches, staff and principal.</p>	<p>RRVSSO Red River Valley Support Staff Organization Award</p> <p>A \$250 cash scholarship will be given to a grad who has faced challenges (Resource help) but has succeeded, shown courage and initiative. The student must be enrolled in post-secondary education, including trades within 2 years of graduation.</p>
<p>Rosenort Credit Union Scholarship</p> <p>A trophy and \$1000 cash scholarship awarded in conjunction with the Mathematics/Science Trophy which is presented by the Rosenort Credit Union each year. The successful recipient has completed the most courses in Mathematics and Science maintaining an average of 75% or higher. The scholarship will be awarded in two equal installments. The first installment will be awarded upon successful registration at a university or Bible School in the field of science, business administration. The second installment will be awarded upon the successful registration for the student's second year of studies. The award may be accepted up to two years after their grade 12 graduation.</p>	<p>Linda Strachen Memorial Bursary</p> <p>This \$50 bursary is awarded to a graduate who has achieved success in learning and life skills with some assistance from Resource Services during some point in his/her school years. Should more than one graduate qualify, the bursary may be awarded on the following: achievement in learning and life skills, self-motivation to learn and accept assistance to improve, presentation on behalf of the students from Teacher/Resource, and the bursary may be co-shared.</p>	<p>Village of Rosenort Award</p> <p>A trophy and \$500 cash bursary is awarded to a graduating student who plans to continue his/her studies in business administration (which includes CMA, CGA, CA, and Law), or rural and urban development studies. Applications for this bursary will be accepted up to two years after graduation. The UVD will be consulted as to the final candidates. The award should be awarded upon need, aptitude and not just scholarship. In the case of a tie for candidacy, the award may be made on the basis of need, evenly split, or have 2 awards offered.</p>

<p>Social Studies Trophy A trophy and \$100 cash award donated by Perimeter Concrete. This award is presented to the student who has taken the most courses in Social Studies maintaining an average of 75% or higher. Subjects include: History 30S, Western Civilization 40S, Law 40S, World Issues 40S, Human Geography 40S.</p>	<p>Business Education A trophy and \$100 cash award donated by Landmark Feeds. This award is presented to the student who has taken the most courses in Business Education maintaining an average of 75% or higher (a minimum of 5 courses required). Subjects include: Accounting 30S, Accounting 40S, Word Processing 30S, Consumer Math 30S, Consumer Math 40S, Software Applications 30S, Business Applications 30S, Desktop Publishing 35S.</p>	<p>Extra-Curricular Award A plaque and \$50 cash award donated by Rosenort School. This award is presented to a graduating male and female student who has participated in many school activities such as Student Council, ISCF, drama, music, intramural programs, Reach and other school sponsored educational programs. The recipients should exemplify school spirit, enthusiasm, and commitment.</p>
<p>Marnie Erb Math Award This award is given to a graduating student who has most improved through personal effort in Math. A \$1000 scholarship will be awarded upon enrollment at a university or college.</p>	<p>Rachel Heinrichs Memorial Award A plaque and \$50 cash award presented to a graduate who demonstrates a real love towards working with children.</p>	<p>Tom Heinrichs Memorial Award A plaque and \$50 cash award presented to a graduate who demonstrates a special aptitude and enthusiasm for sports.</p>
